

Activities with Lifeliqe: Creating presentations with interactive content

Lifeliqe offers many ways to export its content to enrich the presentations of teachers and students. Here are some tips!

How to do it?

First, we will show you how to add screenshots of a 3D model or a direct link to it into your presentations:

1. Open a model and click the **Share** button in the bottom panel.
2. Choose from the **Screenshot** and **Transparent screenshot** option within the newly opened **Share** panel. The first option allows you to take a screenshot of the model on a colored background. By choosing the latter option, a screenshot with a transparent background gets taken.
3. You can also capture different parts of the 3D animation, highlight different parts of the models, etc.
4. When you are finished taking screenshots, choose the desired saving option at the bottom of the right panel. The screenshots can either be stored on Google Drive or on your hard drive.
5. Insert the created screenshots into your presentation. You can paint or write over them or combine them with other resources.
6. You can add direct links to the model into your presentation (see other **Share** feature options).

How can I use it for teaching?

Both teachers and students can work in a similar way while making presentations. Students can also use it while working on a paper, present a given topic to their colleagues or document their project.
