

Activities with Lifeliqe: Creating reports and tasks with 3D models

Lifeliqe is not a tool just for teachers. Learn how to enable students to enrich their materials, be it notes, papers or homework.

How to do it?

To work with Lifeliqe, students need to have an account first. Here's a way they can use Lifeliqe's interactive content in their materials once they have signed up:

1. Open any 3D model and click the **Share** button.
2. Choose from the **Screenshot** and **Transparent screenshot** option within the newly opened **Share** panel. The first option allows you to take a screenshot of the model on a colored background. By choosing the latter option, a screenshot with a transparent background gets taken.
3. You can also capture different parts of the 3D animation, highlight different parts of the models, etc.
4. When you are finished taking screenshots, choose the desired saving option at the bottom of the right panel. The screenshots can either be stored on Google Drive or on your hard drive.
5. These images can be inserted into almost any file type (text documents, spreadsheets, presentations...). Imagination knows no limits!

How can I use it for teaching?

Assign your students a task, let them make a report on the topic to present it to their classmates, share it in a common folder on the cloud, have them present it on the Internet, make them write a paper... The options are countless!
